The University of Zielona Góra

The University of Zielona Góra was established in 2001. It is the largest university in the Lubusz Province, made up of 12 faculties and 29 institutes. It provides education in over 60 fields of study, offer 1st and 2nd degree studies, full-time and part-time studies as well as postgraduate ones. Graduates may also join one of the two Doctoral Schools: the Humanities and Social Sciences or the Exact and Technical Sciences. Nearly 10 thousand students are studying at UZG.

The University Library

The **University Library** is truly a gem with its vast and varied collections. It is located in a spacious, modern building, free from architectural barriers. It is not only a traditional library where students come to borrow books: its visitors are offered computer workstations, multimedia and didactic laboratories, individual and team



Erasmus+? What is it all about?

The Erasmus+ is the European Union program in the field of education, training, youth and sports. Its aim is to support pupils, students, teachers, lecturers and volunteers in conducting international projects aimed at increasing professional competences. The European Union intends to provide all young people with access to education and training of the highest quality,

enable learners to move with ease among education systems in different countries, and give them the opportunity to find work across Europe. The National Agency of the Erasmus+ Program and its implementer in Poland is the Foundation for the Development of the Education System.

Erasmus+ supports EU transparency and recognition tools for skills and qualifications - in particular the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System for Higher Education (ECTS). The aim is to facilitate the recognition of skills and qualifications within and outside countries in all education and training subsystems and on the labour market.

The Erasmus+ program may be accessed by, among others, universities, and thus, above all, students. As part of this educa-



Program participants may study and follow the educational program of one of the foreign universities participating in the Erasmus+ programme. European students may apply to study at any stage of their studies: bachelor's, engineering, master's.

Erasmus+ is not just a student exchange programme, but a lot more! Individuals taking part in the program are provided with the opportunity to join an internship abroad (the minimum period is 60 days). In contrast to the student exchange program, where the list of universities is clearly defined, students and staff wishing to do an internship need to find a company on their own. Later on, they should contact the organization and find out if there is an internship opportunity for people participating in the Erasmus+ program. And that's all! So simple, isn't it?

Internships as part of international cooperation organized by the European Union can be done in various places, for example:

- Companies,
- Scientific and research institutions,
- Non-profit organizations,
- Universities.
- State administration units,
- Public institutions such as libraries and museums.

The internships organized by Erasmus Plus are available in 27 countries of the European Union and in the countries of the European Economic Area, namely: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and North Macedonia, Serbia and Turkey.

Over the course of many years of implementing the Erasmus+ Program at UZG, a solid and stable group of partners from European Union countries, as well as from non-EU countries, the so-called partner countries, has been developed. The Erasmus+ offer at UZ embraces over 150 universities in 36 countries in Europe and all over the world!

Electric buses

In Zielona Góra, we promote electromobility. Municipal Transport Company boasts 86 low-floor buses - including 43 electric ones! Every day, 71 buses roam the city streets, offering service to passengers 7 days a week. With the modern Passenger Transfer Center, located in the vicinity of the railway station, the yellow, white and green bus may be taken almost directly from the railway station. Students use fare-reduced tickets - on the basis of a valid student ID.

Electric scooters

To use electric scooters in Zielona Góra, special application must be installed on the phone. Scooters do not have their own stations. They can be left anywhere within the designated area.

ACTIVE RELAXATION

Bicycle paths

Due to the extensive and constantly expanding network of bicycle routes, trips may successfully be planned, including the most interesting points on the tourist map of the Zielona Góra area. Not only can the city be travelled on two wheels, but you may also



get to attractions located outside the centre of Zielona Góra. Among them, the following should be mentioned: The Prince's Park in Zatonie or the Oder Forest.

Zielona Góra on foot

Hiking and Nordic walking trails in Zielona Góra are an option for bright afternoons and weekends. Especially if you go to the Piast Hills, which are visited by lovers of walks for a reason. A dozen well-marked routes will lead you through the picturesque areas of Zielona Góra. We also invite you to take a walk around the old town to see colorful tenement houses, numerous cafes and tiny figurines of Bacchus (the socalled ,bachusiki' /baa-who-'see-key), of which there are over 60 in Zielona Góra. Three of them are located at the University of Zielona Góra, namely: UZetikus, Banachus and ŻakUZ Jubilatus. The appearance of all Bacchus figurines allude to the wine traditions of the city. They are funded by institutions or private persons.

The Botanical Garden

Near the Piastowski Park, there is the Botanical Garden of the University of Zielona Góra, managed by the university content, education- and science-wise. Established in 2007, it has been a great place for walks and rest, e.g. with a book ever since. It is open all year round. Admission tickets: reduced - PLN 1, regular - PLN 2. Organized groups can walk around the Garden with a guide.

SPORTS

Recreation and Sports Center

You can spend your free time actively at the CRS, where there is a sports and entertainment hall for 5,000 people, hosting numerous sports and cultural events at the world level. There is also a swimming pool area, incl. a 25-meter-long, 8-lane swimming pool, one of the longest tubular slides in Poland, which is 210 m long, and a water balloon. The spa area is adjoined to the pool area.



Provincial Sports and Recreation Center

The Center is located in Drzonków, and modern pentathlon World Cup competition, among others, is organized there which will surely attract many students. Swimming, horse riding, shooting are just some of the list of sports that can be practiced there.

The Aeroclub of the Lubusz Region

One of 46 branches of the Polish Aero Club operates in Przylep. This is also where the famous "Żelazny" aerobatic group has one of its bases. In addition to admiring the sky shows, you can also jump with a parachute or learn to pilot. It is also a great place to have a picnic or admire stunning sunsets!
